## ORDINANCE NO. 85-33 AC CMS

## AN ORDIANCE TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE CURRENT REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current state law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, Council heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revision which is presently before Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 1985 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

529.01 Definitions (Amended).

533.14 Pandering Material Involving a Minor (Added).

Chapter 537 Offenses Against Persons (Amended).

545.01 Definitions (Amended).

545.19 Tampering with Utilities (Added).

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
