

ORDINANCE NO. 85-47 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE GRANT TENDERED BY THE OHIO COMMISSION
ON AGING THROUGH THE LORAIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF
PARTIAL REIMBURSEMENT FOR OBERLIN SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT
THEREFORE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the reimbursement funding grant for Senior Citizen Services
for the 1985 program year in the amount of \$6,500.00 as tendered to the City by
the Ohio Commission on Aging through the Lorain County Commissioners' Office is
hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the agree-
ment on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were
adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, in-
cluding Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date
allowed by law.
