

ORDINANCE NO. 85-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLS INTERNATIONAL OF
CLEVELAND, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING OF A SEWER INSPECTION TELEVISION CAMERA
FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the PLS International Company of Cleveland,
Ohio, being the lowest and best submitted, for the furnishing of a Sewer
Inspection Television Camera for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, Public Works
Department, is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$22,087.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were
adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements,
including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date
allowed by law.
