

ORDINANCE NO. 85-6 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SOMERS AGENCY, INC., OF ELYRIA, OHIO,  
FOR MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET AND CONTRACTOR'S EQUIPMENT INSURANCE COVERAGE  
FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Somers Agency, Inc., of Elyria, Ohio, for  
Motor Vehicle Fleet and Contractor's Equipment insurance coverage for the  
City of Oberlin, being the lowest and best bid received, that bid being  
\$9,795 for Automobile Fleet and \$1,589 for Contractor's Equipment, is hereby  
accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter  
into a contract accordingly, said bid being attached hereto and incorporated  
herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions  
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance  
were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations  
of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal  
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in effect at the earliest date  
allowed by law.
