#### ORDINANCE NO. 85-74 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF USUAL AND ORDINARY EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 1986, UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS MEASURE SHALL BE PASSED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be and is hereby authorized to pay all ordinary and usual bills and salaries in the City on and after January 1, 1986, until such time as an annual appropriations ordinance shall be adopted.

SECTION 2. That the City Auditor shall allow payments for such ordinary and usual expenses to be made against the attached preliminary draft of the 1986 appropriations ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit A. Any and all such ordinary and usual expenses shall be charged to the annual appropriations amounts once such measure is adopted.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to insure the timely payment of the ordinary and usual expenses of the City"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

WHEREAS, the City further desires conperation from the Director of Transportation in the planning, design and construction of said improvement,

NDW THERERORE, Se it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin Ohio:

SECTION 1 (Cooperation)

That said City hereby requests the cooperation of the Director of Transportation in the cost of the above described improvement as follows:

- The City of Oberlin agrees to assume and bear ten percent (10%) of the total cost of the improvement in the City, and
- 2) Further, the City will assume and bear all costs for any extra work requested by the City and not necessary for the improvement, as determined by the State.

SECTION II '(Consent)

That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said City'be and such consent is hereby given to the Director of Transportation to construct the above described improvement, in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Director.

SECTION III (Authority to Sign)

That the <u>City Manager</u> of said City, is hereby empowered and directed on behalf of the City to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the planning and construction of this improvement.

SECTION IV (Traffic Control Signals and Devices)

That truffic control devices installed within the limits of the project will conform with Section 4511 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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SECTION V (Maintenance and Parking)

That upon completion of said improvement, said City, will thereafter keep said highway open to truffic at all times, and

- (a) Maintain the improvement in accordance with the provisions of the statuted relating thereto and make ample financial and other provisions for such maintenance; and
- (b) Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions in a manner satisfactory to the State of Ohio and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes and permit no signs, posters, billboards, readside stands or other private installations within the right-of-way limits; and
- (c) Place and maintain all traffic control devices conforming to the Dhio Hanual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices on the improvement in compliance with the provisions of Section 4511.11 and related sections of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (d) Regulate parking in the following manner:

No parking permitted on pavement within the limits of the improvement.

# SECTION VI (Right-of-way, Utility Rearrangement and Saving the State of Chio Harmless of Darages)

- (a) That all existing street and public way right-of-way within the City Which is necessary for the aforesaid improvement, shall be made available therefor.
- (b) That the State XXXX will acquire any additional right-of-way required for the construction of the aforesaid improvement.
- (c) That arrangements have been or will be made with and agreements obtained from all public utility companies whose lines or structures will be affected by the said improvement and siad companies have agreed to make any and all necessary plant removals or rearrangements in such a manner as to be clear of any construction called for by the plans of said improvement and said companies have agreed to make such necessary rearrangements immediately after notification by said City or the Department of Transportation.
- (d) That it is hereby agreed that the City shall at its own expense, make all rearrangements of water mains, service lines, fire hydrants, valve boxes, sanitary sewers or other municipally owned utilities and/or any appurtenances thereto, which do not comply with the provisions of Directive 28-A, whether inside or outside the corporate limits as may be necessary to conform to the said improvement and said rearrangements shall be done at such time as requested by the Department of Transportation Engineer.
- (e) That the construction, reconstruction, and/or rearrangement of both publicly and privately owned utilities, referred to in subsections (c) and (d) above, shall be done in such a manner as not to interfere unduly with the operation of the contractor constructing the improvement and all backfilling of trenches made necessary by such utility rearrangements shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications and shall be subject to approval by the State.
- (f) That the installation of all utility (actilities on the right of way shall conform with the requirements of the Pederal Highway Administration Policy and Procedure Memorandum 10-4 "Utility Relocations and Adjustments" and the Dupartment of Transportation's rules on Utility Accommodation. . .
- (9) That said City hereby agrees that the said Department of Transportation of the State of Onio, shall be and is hereby saved harmless from any and all damages or claims chereof arising from or growing out of the certification or obligations made or agreed to in Sections (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) horeinabove.

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This ordinance is horsby declared to be an emargency measure by reason of the need for expediting highway improvements to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
