RESOLUTION NO. R85-5 CMS

A RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSED FINDINGS AND ORDERS
SET FORTH IN THE DRAFT OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY PERMIT AND
AUTHORIZATION TO DISCHARGE FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency has issued proposed Findings and Orders concerning the City of Oberlin Wastewater Treatment Plant, and,

WHEREAS, the City feels that said proposed Findings and Orders are not technically feasible; and are economically unreasonable for the citizens of the City of Oberlin;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin hereby objects to the proposed Findings and Orders as set forth in the draft Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Permit and Authorization to Discharge for the City of Oberlin Wastewater Treatment Plant, as said Findings and Orders are not the most technically feasible, and are economically unreasonable.

SECTION 2. That the City of Oberlin hereby requests that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency allow a modification to said proposed Findings and Orders to avoid unreasonable economic hardship to the citizens of the City of Oberlin and to allow the City to proceed in an orderly fashion with Wastewater Treatment Plant improvements and collection system repairs and replacements.

Section 3. That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to-wit:

"to voice the concern of the elected officials of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, in this matter at the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
