

ORDINANCE NO. 86-29 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FINKBEINER, PETTIS & STROUT, LIMITED,
OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES
FOR PHASE I SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Limited, of Akron, Ohio, who is subcontracting with Ralph C. Tyler, Limited, an MBE firm, for the furnishing of design engineering services for the Phase I sewer improvements, said services to be performed as outlined in the proposal dated April 24, 1986, and made a part of the contract by reference. Said services shall be for a fixed fee not to exceed \$29,451.78.

SECTION 2. That Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Limited, shall subcontract with Ralph C. Tyler, Limited, for survey services. Said subcontract services shall be in an amount approximating \$11,600.00 and shall be included in the basic design services fee outlined above in Section 1.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
