## ORDINANCE NO. 86-39 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SOMERS AGENCY OF ELYRIA, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC OFFICIALS LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THAT INSURANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the following insurance company and its agent, being the lowest and best bid for supplying insurance coverage for the City of Oberlin, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract accordingly:
