## ORDINANCE NO. 86-40 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER PLANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR DIESEL FUEL FOR SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has advertised for bids for diesel fuel oil for the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant, and

WHEREAS, no bids were submitted in response to said advertisement to bid, and,

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant needs diesel fuel oil immediately in order to continue operation, and,

WHEREAS, said need has created a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of that public utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the following companies for the supply of Mo. 2 Diesel Fuel Oil to the City of Oberlin for use at the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant for the period of April 1, 1986, to November 1, 1986, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00:

- 1. Standard Oil Company of Ohio, Cleveland, Ohio
- 2. Alpha Omega, Inc., Cleveland, Ohio
- 3. Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Procurement, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 125.04

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for the purchase of said fuel oil is hereby declared to constitute a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to ensure the continuous operation of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant"  $\,$ 

· and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
