

ORDINANCE NO. 86-54 AC CMS

DEFEATED

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT CO., INC.
OF BRUNSWICK, OHIO, FOR A BACKHOE-LOADER FOR
THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc. of Brunswick, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for supplying a 1986 Backhoe-Loader for the City of Oberlin, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:

1986 Case 580 SE with Extendable Dipperstick	\$32,544.00
Less Trade-In of a 1976 Massey Ferguson Backhoe-Loader	- 5,200.00
Total	<u>\$27,344.00</u>

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
