

ORDINANCE NO. 86-70 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS
IN THE STATE OF THE SOUTH PROFESSOR STREET BRIDGE AT MORGAN STREET
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
FOR THE REPAIR OF THE BRIDGE

WHEREAS, upon inspection by the Engineer of the City of Oberlin and
the Engineer of Lorain County, it was found that the South Professor Street
bridge at Morgan Street is in a serious state of disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the poor condition of the bridge is a serious threat to
the health, safety and welfare of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the bridge is in need of immediate repair in order to insure
the continued safe use of this public right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into
a contract with J. D. Williamson Construction Co., Inc., of Tallmadge,
Ohio, for the furnishing of bridge repairs to the South Professor Street
bridge, said contract to be in an amount not to exceed \$76,884.23.

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for the bridge construction repairs
is hereby declared to constitute a real and present emergency arising
in connection with the safe use of a public right-of-way, pursuant to
Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance
were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations
of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to insure the continued safe use of a public right-of-way"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
