## RESOLUTION NO. R86-13 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF A TAX LEVY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE OBERLIN PUBLIC LIBRARY PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.23 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Public Library, a public library supported by the City of Oberlin, has submitted to the Council of the City of Oberlin by Resolution adopted August 5, 1986, by a two-thirds vote of all its members, a request that this Council submit to the electors of the City of Oberlin, the question of the renewal of a tax levy of 2 mills for current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library, and,

WHEREAS, Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes this Council to submit to a vote of the electors said renewal levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Oberlin, for the purpose of providing funds to meet the current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library within the City of Oberlin at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each One Dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.20 for each One Hundred Dollars of valuation for each of the years 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1990.

SECTION 2. That said levy is a renewal of an existing levy for five (5) years for the purpose of providing funds to meet the current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library within the City of Oberlin in accordance with Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That said levy shall be placed upon the ballot at an election which shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of 1986, being November 4, 1986.

SECTION 4. That said levy shall be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if  $\alpha$  majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION 5. That the Clark of the Council of the City of observed the Ohio- be and is hereby directed to scruify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Loran Lounty, Elyria, Ohio, prior to the 21st day of August, 1986, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

SECTION 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to meet the time requirements of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code and to provide funds necessary for the continued operation of the Public Library"

and shall take effect immediatley upon passage.
