

ORDINANCE NO. 87-32 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT  
WITH OBERLIN COLLEGE FOR THE USE OF CRANE POOL BY THE  
RECREATION DEPARTMENT SUMMER SWIM PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed agreement between the City of Oberlin  
and Oberlin College for the use of Crane Pool by the City of Oberlin Recre-  
ation Department Summer Swim program, a copy of which is attached hereto  
and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved, and the City  
Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of  
the City, said contract being in the amount of \$5,750.00.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions

## Services Required:

- Custodial coverage of locker rooms, pool area, and connecting hallways.
- Oberlin College personnel and Rec Center members permitted to swim free with OCID during recreation swims.

## Fees:

- \$5,750.00 (NOTE: If the pool should be down for more than four consecutive hours as a result of variables controlled by the College, this figure will be adjusted by using a daily rental rate of \$119.79 for twelve hours of daily usage.)
- The City agrees to pay all guards except Oberlin College swim (5:00-5:45pm Monday through Saturday) and to supply guards for this time.

The renter is responsible for the return and good condition of all property rented through this contract.

The renter must comply with all regulations of the College and the laws of the State of Ohio.

Food, beverages, or liquor may not be brought into buildings without prior approval from the Conference Services Office.

The College is responsible for maintenance of the facility and will not bill for normal maintenance or for items purchased which will remain the property of the pool, though subsequent rental agreements will reflect such purchases.

The City agrees to provide a Certificate of Insurance acceptable to Oberlin College. Such insurance shall be written for not less than the limits of liability specified below:

Bodily Injury	\$1,000,000 each occurrence
Property Damage	\$1,000,000 each occurrence
Personal Injury	\$1,000,000 each occurrence

Bodily Injury, Property Damage, Personal Injury	\$1,000,000 aggregate

Certificates of Insurance shall be filed with the College prior to the commencement of any use of College premises. The Certificates shall contain a provision that coverage as afforded under the policies will not be cancelled until at least ten (10) days' prior written notice has been given to Oberlin College.

I declare that the statements on this form are true and correct to the best of my knowledge. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Agreement or any College regulation shall be sufficient cause for the cancellation of the reservation.
