AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND THE OBERLIN YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF A YOUTH SOCCER PROGRAM WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE 1T ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Oberlin Youth Soccer Association for the operation of a youth soccer program within the City of Oberlin, a copy being attached hereto and incorporated by reference, is hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

AGREÉMENT

This Agreement will serve as confirmation of the City of Oberlin Recreation Department's proposed support of the Oberlin Youth Soccer Association. Following are terms by which both the City of Oberlin Recreation Department and the Oberlin Youth Soccer Association obligate themselves toward their participation in the implementation of a community-wide soccer program for Oberlin youths.

This Agreement is made and entered into at Oberlin, Ohio, this 16th day of June, 1987, by and between the City of Oberlin Recreation Department (hereinafter referred to as "City") and the Oberlin Youth Soccer Association (hereinafter referred to as "Soccer Association").

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous to implement a soccer program for Oberlin youths,

In consideration of the mutual terms and obligations contained herein and other consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Proposal and Terms of Agreement

The Soccer Association has proposed that the City increase its support of the community soccer program to include administrative and maintenance contributions. This function had been previously performed by volunteers that constituted the Soccer Association.

Both parties agree that the terms of this agreement are for a one (1) year period with the City having the right to renew the agreement for a period of two successive one (1) year periods, so long as each party abides by all the obligations set forth herein, subject, however, to termination as provided for herein.

2. Duties and Obligations of the City

The City shall perform the following duties and obligations during the term of this Agreement:

- (A) Provide field maintenance, which shall include preparing soccer fields for scheduled games.
- (B) Conduct player registration and handle all telephone inquiries regarding community soccer program.
- (C) Provide training for volunteer soccer coaches under the National Youth Sport Coaching Association.
- (D) Provide training for officials that will conform with the Lorain County Soccer Association requirements.
- (E) Provide for press releases that will be at no cost to the City.

3. Duties and Obligations of Association

The Soccer Association shall perform the following duties and obligations during the term of this Agreement:

- (A) Recruit and provide volunteers to be trained for coaching positions.
- (B) Provide for free transportation of players, coaches, scorekeepers and managers to and from games.
- (C) Pay for all advertising not provided by the City assumed under Section 2(E) of this Agreement.
- (D) Provide for the placement of the participants on the various teams.
- (E) Continue to perform those duties, as described in the bylaws under Articles IV, VI and IX, governing the Oberlin Youth Soccer, i.e., attend County meetings, ordering and purchasing of equipment, etc.
- 4. As of the signing of this Agreement the City will not provide an

instructional league (open-gym type) program, nor will the City provide liability insurance for the Soccer Association.

Termination

In the event that either party breaches the terms and conditions contained herein, this Agreement may be terminated by giving written notice to the other party of such termination at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of desired termination.

The Soccer Association and the City of Oberlin hereby agree with the terms of this Agreement.
