ORDINANCE NO. 87-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND THE COMMISSIONERS OF LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, FOR THE RESURFACING OF OBERLIN ROAD AND RELATED WORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, for the resurfacing, widening and associated improvement work to Oberlin Road, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City, said contract to be in an amount not to exceed \$58,786.99.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to eliminate hazardous road conditions at the earliest possible date and ensure completion of the improvement project prior to the onset of inclement weather"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Commissioners passed Resolution No. 87-428 on June 4, 1987, wherein the Commissioners resolved to accept bids for resurfacing Oberlin Road from State Route 10 to Russia Road; and

WHEREAS, the said Commissioners stated in the Resolution that this resurfacing was to be a cooperative effort between the Commissioners and the City of Oberlin, Ohio, with said City paying part of the cost of the resurfacing, and the balance of same to be paid by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Ohio passed Ordinance No. 87-33 AC CMS on June 1, 1987, wherein the City authorized the expenditure of up to Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$59,000.00), towards the resurfacing of Oberlin Road from State Route 10 to Russia Road, which project was to be a cooperative effort with the Lorain County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Commissioners awarded the contract to Erie Blacktop, Inc. on July 2, 1987, for the aforementioned project;

WITNESSETH:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Oberlin, Ohio shall pay sum Forty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Six Dollars and Ninety-nine cents (\$42,786.99) plus contingencies, and the Lorain County Commissioners shall pay sum One Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars and Ninety-one cents (\$195,897.91), towards the contract awarded to Erie Blacktop, Inc., P.O. Box 2308, Sandusky, Ohio 44840 on July 2, 1987, amounting to sum Two Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$238,684.90), for resurfacing Oberlin Road from State Route 10 to Russia Road.

In order to reflect the intent of the parties to fully cooperate in all aspects of this project including MBE/WBE representation in the same, the parties subscribe their names to duplicate originals of this Agreement, on the 2nd day of July, 1987.
