

ORDINANCE NO. 87-50 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF H. FIOR OF AMHERST, OHIO,
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO THE LINE SHOP
FOR THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all
members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of H. Fior of Amherst, Ohio, for
an addition of approximately 1,200 square feet to the Line Shop
for the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System being the lowest
and best bid received, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager
is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract
accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$96,277.00, and
said monies are hereby so appropriated.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all
formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the
adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of
the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of
any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit:


"to authorize a contract prior to the expiration of the
bid and to ensure completion of the construction project
prior to the onset of inclement weather"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
