

ORDINANCE NO. 87-66 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
WITH APPRAISERS INC. OF CANTON, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING OF
APPRAISAL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposal of Appraisers Inc. of Canton, Ohio, dated September 23, 1987, for the furnishing of appraisal services to the City of Oberlin, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said proposal being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and in an amount not to exceed \$16,850, subject to compliance with the Oberlin EEO ordinance.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to insure compliance with state statutes concerning auditing procedures"
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
