

ORDINANCE NO. 88-36 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN REGARD TO THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIEMENS ENERGY AND AUTOMATION OF LORAIN, OHIO, FOR THE REPAIR OF AN ENGINE GENERATOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on May 5, 1988, an electrical short circuit and fire occurred at the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant which damaged the Number Eight engine generator; and,

WHEREAS, if said generator is not immediately repaired the safe and efficient operation of the Light and Power System is in jeopardy; and,

WHEREAS, the failure of said motor represents a serious threat to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Siemens Energy and Automation of Lorain, Ohio, for the furnishing of repairs to the Number Eight engine generator at the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System, said contract to be in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for said electric generator repair is hereby declared to constitute a real and present emergency arising in connection with the safe and efficient operation of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to ensure the continued safe and efficient operation of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
