AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO BE USED FOR THE CORRECTION OF EXCESSIVE INFILTRATION AND INFLOW RELATIVE TO THE EXISTING SEWER SYSTEM AND ADDITIONS AND MODIFICATIONS TO THE EXISTING WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency in the amount of \$2,851,746.00 is hereby accepted by the City of Oberlin, Ohio and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a grant agreement therefor.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to accept a grant and enter into a grant agreement as soon as possible so that construction on the proposed sewer improvement project may proceed immediately"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
