

ORDINANCE NO. 88-96 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR CHEMICALS USED IN THE WATER TREATMENT
AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANTS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO
FOR THE YEAR 1989

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following being the lowest and best bids for
certain chemicals used by the Water Treatment Plant for water treatment
and by the Wastewater Treatment Plant for wastewater treatment, for the
year 1989, are hereby accepted, and the City Manager is authorized to
enter into a contract accordingly:
