

RESOLUTION NO. R88-8 CMS

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT A PUBLIC EMERGENCY EXISTS
CONCERNING THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, WATER SUPPLY AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUSPEND THE SUPPLY OF WATER FOR CERTAIN
NON-ESSENTIAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 911.10 of the Codified Ordinances
of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, City Council hereby determines that a state
of public emergency exists concerning the water supply of the City of
Oberlin due to the severe drought conditions presently in existence.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager, in consultation with the Water
Superintendent and Public Works Director, is hereby authorized to suspend
the supply of water for all purposes set forth in Section 911.10 of the
Codified Ordinances, or any combination thereof, until said public emergency
no longer exists.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution
were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations
of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to authorize the immediate suspension of the use of municipal water
for non-essential purposes during a time of severe drought"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
