ORDINANCE NO. 89-74 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ENVIRO-GRO TECHNOLOGIES OF INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA, FOR THE REMOVAL OF LIME RESIDUE FROM THE LAGOON AT THE OBERLIN WATER TREATMENT PLANT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Enviro-Gro Technologies of Indianapolis, Indiana, for the removal and disposal of lime residue from the lagoon at the Oberlin Water Treatment Plant, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$33.90 per dry ton of lime residue and not to exceed \$200,000.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
