

ORDINANCE NO. 90-38 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO  
A CONTRACT WITH CONSOLIDATED ENGINEERING OF ELYRIA, OHIO,  
FOR SURVEY WORK FOR THE PROPOSED OBERLIN BIKE PATH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County  
of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposal of Consolidated Engineering of  
Elyria, Ohio, for survey work for the proposed Oberlin Bike Path,  
a copy of said proposal being attached hereto and incorporated herein  
by reference, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby  
authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said  
proposal not to exceed \$27,000.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal  
actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of  
this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees  
that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the  
public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest  
date allowed by law.
