ORDINANCE NO. 90-48 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT TO RECOUP COSTS FOR COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Oberlin Municipal Court for the recoupment by the City of expenses associated with computer equipment purchased for the Oberlin Municipal Court, a copy of said contract being attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
