

ORDINANCE NO. 90-6 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
A CONTRACT WITH PUBLIC ENTITIES POOL OF OHIO,
CINCINNATI, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING TO THE CITY
OF OBERLIN, OHIO, OF COVERAGE FOR MUNICIPAL GENERAL
LIABILITY RISKS, AND MUNICIPAL AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY AND
AUTOMOBILE PHYSICAL DAMAGE RISKS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County
of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter
into a contract with Public Entities Pool of Ohio, Cincinnati,
Ohio, for the furnishing to the City of Oberlin, Ohio, of coverage
for municipal general liability risks, and municipal automobile
liability and automobile physical damage risks pursuant to their
bid of January 9, 1990, said bid being in an amount of \$70,905.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal
actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of
this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees
that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the
public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of
Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure uninterrupted liability insurance coverage for the
City of Oberlin, Ohio,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
