

ORDINANCE NO. 90-67 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING THAT THE COMMISSIONERS OF LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, APPLY TO THE STATE OF OHIO, OFFICE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES, FOR A 1990 FISCAL YEAR FORMULA ALLOCATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,700 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests that the Commissioners of Lorain County apply to the State of Ohio, Office of Local Government Services, for a 1990 Fiscal Year Formula Allocation Grant in the amount of \$28,700 for the benefit of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the application to be filed by the Lorain County Commissioners shall be for street improvements for the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That the Lorain County Commissioners shall, upon receipt of said funds, administer the grant activities on behalf of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall receive 5% (five percent) of the grant monies received to cover the costs of said administrative duties. The City of Oberlin will implement the grant activities.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
