

ORDINANCE NO. 90-78 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING DEBORAH G. KIMBLE  
INTERIM CLERK OF CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Deborah G. Kimble is hereby appointed interim Clerk of the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, during the maternity leave of Julie A. Simonson, from November 16, 1990, through March 1, 1991.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to provide for an interim Clerk to Oberlin City Council at the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
