

RESOLUTION NO. R90-10 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE LITTER PREVENTION AND RECYCLING PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE OHIO LITTER CONTROL ACT OF 1980, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, millions of dollars are spent in Ohio each year to collect and landfill recyclables which otherwise become a solid waste or litter problem; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the existence of a solid waste problem within the boundaries of the City of Oberlin and the need to address the problem at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Litter Control Act of 1980, provides, through the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Litter Prevention and Recycling, for the purpose of allocation of funds in the form of grants for the purposes of supplemental local Litter Prevention and Recycling Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby endorses and supports a Litter Prevention and Recycling Program for the City of Oberlin and authorizes the necessary funds to implement said program, if approved, as indicated in its application.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into agreement with the Department to administer a grant to implement said program, and that the City Manager is authorized to sign said agreement.

SECTION 3. That the City of Oberlin hereby requests the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Litter Prevention and Recycling, to consider and fund its application project.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to timely file an application for said project by the filing deadline of August 31, 1990"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
