RESOLUTION NO. R90-9 CMS

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN INDIGENT DRIVERS ALCOHOL TREATMENT ACCOUNT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 4511.191 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established, as part of the General Fund of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, an Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Account, as required by Section 4511.191 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. That there shall be deposited into said account all monies required to be so deposited by Sections 4511.191 and 4511.99 of the Ohio Revised Code, said monies to be expended only upon order of the Judge of the Oberlin Municipal Court and only for payment of the cost of the attendance at an alcohol and drug addiction treatment program of a person who is convicted of a violation of Sections 4511.19 of the Ohio Revised Code or a substantially similar Municipal Ordinance, who is ordered by the Court to attend the alcohol and drug addiction treatment program, and who is determined by the Court to be unable to pay the cost of his or her attendance at the treatment program.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
