AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF VAUGHN ELECTRIC; INC., OF CAREY, OHIO FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ELECTRIC SUBSTATION AND 69 KV LINE FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN.
