

ORDINANCE NO. 91-61 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF  
ELECTRICAL CORPORATION OF AMERICA, OF LORAIN, OHIO, FOR  
ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR SERVICES FOR THE OBERLIN WATER TREATMENT  
PLANT STANDBY GENERATOR AND SERVICE BUILDING PROJECT  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Electrical Corporation of America, of Lorain, Ohio, for electrical contractor services for the Oberlin Water Treatment Plant Standby Generator and Service Building Project, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the total amount, including acceptable alternatives, of \$453,636.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the beginning of construction prior to the end of the 1991 construction season"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
