

ORDINANCE NO. 91-79 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE MID-RANGE STRATEGIC PLAN
FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND THE RECOMMENDATIONS
OF THE STRATEGIC PLAN STEERING COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, since 1988 the City of Oberlin has been engaged in the process of formulating a strategic plan for the City which would allow the City to grow and prosper through planned development; and,

WHEREAS, a proposed Mid-Range Strategic Plan has finally been formulated which the City desires to formally adopt, along with the recommendations of the Strategic Plan Steering Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed City of Oberlin Mid-Range Strategic Plan dated October 7, 1991, and the three (3) specific recommendations of the Strategic Plan Steering Committee concerning said Plan are hereby adopted, said recommendations being as follows:

1. RECOMMENDATION: The Steering Committee will, by July 1, 1992, develop and propose to Council legislation setting out a process and timetable for the preparation and updating, annually, of a five or six year development plan. The roles and responsibilities of members of city staff, commissions, council members and others as necessary shall be set out in the legislation.
2. RECOMMENDATION: Building on the work of the Economic Development Task Force, the Financial Task Force and the Community Improvement Corporation, a task force on economic and financial development should be established, with a schedule for reporting on projects spread over the period from the adoption of this recommendation through December 31, 1992, on the timetable proposed in the body of the report.
3. RECOMMENDATION: That a list be published of those task force proposals that have been implemented and that the council, administration, commissions, and steering committee be instructed to implement or recommend action on further recommendations as listed and in accordance with the timetable in sections of the report that follows.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of

this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
