

ORDINANCE NO. 91-95 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$4,900.00
FROM THE CABLE COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAMMING FUND FOR
THE PURCHASE OF LOCAL CABLE PROGRAMMING EQUIPMENT,
EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE AND SUPPLIES AND PROGRAMMING LABOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County
of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby authorized the expenditure of
Four Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$4,900.00) from the City of
Oberlin cable Communications Programming Fund for equipment
maintenance and supplies, programming labor, and the purchase of
the following local cable programming equipment which upon purchase
shall be subject to the lease agreement between the City and
Oberlin Cable Co-Op, Inc., dated August 22, 1990:
