

RESOLUTION NO. R91-16 CMS

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION SERVICE BEING PROVIDED TO THE RESIDENTS OF
THE CITY OF OBERLIN BY THE OBERLIN COMMUNITY SERVICES
COUNCIL AND ENCOURAGING THE LORAIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
TO ALLOW THE OBERLIN COMMUNITY SERVICES COUNCIL TO CONTINUE
PROVIDING SAID SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Community Services Council has provided excellent transportation services to the residents of the Oberlin area for many years, and,

WHEREAS, due to certain County bidding requirements the providing of those transportation services by the Oberlin Community Services Council may be in jeopardy, and

WHEREAS, Oberlin City Council desires to formally acknowledge the excellent public transportation services that have been and are currently being provided to Oberlin area residents by the Oberlin Community Services Council and encourage the Lorain County Commissioners to allow the Oberlin Community Services Council to continue providing those services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Oberlin City Council does hereby commend the Oberlin Community Services Council on the excellent public transportation services that it has provided and currently does provide to the residents of the Oberlin area.

SECTION 2. That the Oberlin City Council does hereby strongly encourage the Lorain County Commissioners and the Lorain County Transit Board to allow the Oberlin Community Services Council to continue providing public transit services to the residents of the Oberlin area.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
