

RESOLUTION NO. R91-9 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,  
TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO TO  
PARTICIPATE IN THE SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
BLOCK GRANT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Department of Development, provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of addressing local needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance for infrastructure improvements for the proposed Hamilton Square Development Project under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio, Department of Development, through its Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oberlin must direct and authorize the City Manager to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Oberlin City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to be the official representative of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, concerning the application to participate in the State of Ohio, Department of Development, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Community Development Program, and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission.

SECTION 2. That the City of Oberlin hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Community Development Program concerning infrastructure improvements for the proposed Hamilton Square Development Project.

SECTION 3. That the City of Oberlin hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION 4. That the City of Oberlin hereby commits itself to provide the local share funding as described in the application.

SECTION 5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
