

ORDINANCE NO. 92-10 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A 90-DAY EXTENSION OF
THE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,
AND THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO,
FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE AND MITIGATION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County
of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby agrees and
consents to a 90-day extension, until March 31, 1992, of the
existing Hazardous Material Response and Mitigation agreement
between the City of Oberlin and the Board of Commissioners of
Lorain County, Ohio, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and
directed to execute said contract extension on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal
actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of
this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees
that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the
public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the
earliest date allowed by law.
