

ORDINANCE NO. 92-25 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND RATIFYING AN AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO AND THE  
OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA) have completed negotiations relating to wages, hours and other conditions of employment for certain members of the Oberlin Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, the OPBA ratified and approved said agreement on March 18, 1992,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed agreement between the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA), as approved by the OPBA on March 18, 1992, is hereby approved and ratified, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
