ORDINANCE NO. 92-33 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 92-29 AC CMS INCREASING THE ANNUAL COMPENSATION OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 92-29 AC CMS is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That the annual compensation of all full-time permanent employees of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, except the City Auditor and City Manager, is hereby increased by \$266, said adjustment to be effective January 1, 1992."

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to clarify language in existing legislation at the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
