

ORDINANCE NO. 92-57 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER  
INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HEALTHSTAR MANAGED CARE CORPORATION  
OF INDEPENDENCE, OHIO, FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF A  
PREFERRED PROVIDER ORGANIZATION FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County  
of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members  
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and  
directed to enter into an agreement with HealthStar Managed Care  
Corporation of Independence, Ohio, for the administration of a  
preferred provider organization for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, a  
copy of the proposed agreement being attached hereto and  
incorporated herein by reference, the cost to be \$3.50 per enrolled  
employee per month plus a one-time set-up fee of \$3.50 per enrolled  
employee.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal  
actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of  
this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and  
that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees  
that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the  
public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public  
peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin,  
Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the completion of contractual arrangements for a  
preferred provider organization for City of Oberlin employees  
at the beginning of the City health plan year"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
