

ORDINANCE NO. 92-62 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND MICHAEL BENZA AND ASSOCIATES OF RICHFIELD, OHIO, TO PROVIDE FOR THE FURNISHING OF GROUND CONTROL (HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL) FOR THE AERIAL SURVEY MAPPING AS PART OF THE PHASE I STORM DRAINAGE PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Engineering Services Agreement between the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and Michael Benza and Associates for consulting engineering services is hereby amended to provide for the furnishing of ground control (horizontal and vertical) for the aerial survey mapping as part of the Phase I Storm Drainage Project, said services to be in accordance with their proposal of September 1, 1992, and to be in an amount not to exceed \$16,900.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to complete aerial survey work so that design work for the Phase I Storm Drainage Project can proceed in a timely manner"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
