

ORDINANCE NO. 92-67 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF  
COMPENSATION FOR THE CLERK OF COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the terms and conditions of compensation for the Clerk of Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, shall be as follows:

- a.) The Clerk shall work 20 hours per week and shall receive compensation in the sum of \$14,300.00 per year, payable bi-weekly. Any hours worked over the normal 20 hours per week will be compensated at the rate of \$13.75 per hour but will be subject to approval of the Chairman of Council.
- b.) The Clerk shall receive 70% of full-time employee vacation benefits and shall be entitled to participate in the City of Oberlin Medical Benefit Plan on the same terms and conditions as full-time City employees.
- c.) There shall be no further accumulation of sick leave benefits after the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
