AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF DEBORAH G. KIMBLE AS CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 21, 1992, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, City Council accepts the resignation of Deborah G. Kimble, City Manager, City of Oberlin, Ohio, effective September 21, 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the written resignation of Deborah G. Kimble as City Manager of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, dated September 21, 1992, a copy being attached hereto, be and the same is hereby formally acknowledged and accepted.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to allow the City Council of the City of Oberlin to immediately begin the search for a successor City Manager"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
