

RESOLUTION NO. R92-11 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO
REPRESENT THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN A PENDING LAWSUIT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to represent and defend the City of Oberlin in a pending lawsuit, being Lorain County Common Pleas Court Case No. 92-CV108611, and titled "Underground Utilities, Inc., vs. City of Oberlin, et. al.," and conduct such discovery and retain such experts as he deems necessary in the premises, all to be charged as extraordinary expenses.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to provide legal defense for a pending lawsuit in a timely manner"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
