RESOLUTION NO. R92-4 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO REPRESENT THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, IN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING NEGOTIATIONS AND HEARINGS WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to represent the City of Oberlin in collective bargaining negotiations and hearings with the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association to be charged to the City as extraordinary expense.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

That this resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the city of Oberlin, to wit:

"to authorize legal representation prior to negotiations"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
