

RESOLUTION NO. R92-5 CMS

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE PYLE ROAD RESERVOIR AREA
AS THE JAMES F. "BILL" LONG NATURE PRESERVE

WHEREAS, the Pyle Road Reservoir has recently been developed into a nature preserve for the use and benefit of the public; and,

WHEREAS, James F. "Bill" Long was instrumental in building community support for the development of said preserve.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Pyle Road reservoir area is hereby designated as the James F. "Bill" Long Nature Preserve, and that the City of Oberlin erect appropriate signs designating that fact.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
