

ORDINANCE NO. 93-1 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING SHARON MILLER CLERK OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL AND OBERLIN CITY TREASURER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Sharon Miller is hereby appointed Clerk of Oberlin City Council and Oberlin City Treasurer, effective January 4, 1993.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk shall work 20 hours per week (4 hours per day) and shall receive as compensation \$9.60 per hour. Additional hours of work, if necessary, shall be approved by the Chair of Council. Fringe benefits shall include participation in PERS, all City paid holidays (based on 4 hours per day) as set forth in section 145.12 of the codified ordinance, and provided vacation allowance (after twenty-four months of service), as provided in section 145.11 (d) of the codified ordinance.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to provide for a Clerk of Council and Treasurer for the City of Oberlin as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the City"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
