

ORDINANCE NO. 93-10 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PUBLIC ENTITIES POOL OF OHIO, CINCINNATI, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, OF COVERAGE FOR MUNICIPAL GENERAL LIABILITY RISKS, FIREFIGHTERS ERRORS AND OMISSIONS RISKS, AND MUNICIPAL AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY AND AUTOMOBILE PHYSICAL DAMAGE RISKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, 5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Public Entities Pool of Ohio, Cincinnati, Ohio, for the furnishing to the City of Oberlin, Ohio, of coverage for the following risks, for the following costs in accordance with their quote of January 13, 1993:

| RISK   | LIMITS/DEDUCTIBLE   | COST     |
|--|---------------------|----------|
| General Liability & Firefighter's Errors and Omissions | \$1,000,000/\$1,000 | \$32,446 |
| Automobile & Liability & Physical Damage               | \$1,000,000/\$250   | \$35,742 |

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure uninterrupted liability coverage for the City of Oberlin, Ohio,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
