## ORDINANCE NO. 93-19 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATE SCHEDULE FOR COMMERCIAL GARBAGE AND RUBBISH COLLECTION IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin desires to amend the rate schedule as established by Ordinance 92-17 AC CMS for all commercial establishments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance there is herewith imposed a garbage and rubbish collection fee as follows:

(a) For each commercial and/or industrial business including, but not limited to nursing homes, schools and pre-school programs, and apartment buildings with five or more units there shall be a graded schedule depending upon weekly quantity of refuse.

For purposes of this section, weekly quantity of refuse collected shall be defined as the capacity of the dumpster times the weekly frequency of collection.

For any commercial and/or industrial business the appropriate Step will be determined by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. Where, the City, in its sole discretion, determines that it cannot provide adequate service to a commercial and/or industrial business, the City Manager shall be authorized to approve the use of a private collection service. All costs associated with the use of such private collection service shall be borne by the customer.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
