

ORDINANCE NO. 93-24 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER  
INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OBERLIN COMMUNITY SERVICES  
COUNCIL FOR THE PROVISION OF AN EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE  
AND REFERRAL PROGRAM FOR OBERLIN RESIDENTS

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Community Services Council is a non-profit organization which provides emergency assistance to low-income persons and a general information and referral program which benefits numerous Oberlin residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin hereby finds and determines that the furnishing of such programs is in the best interests of the citizens of the City and constitutes a proper municipal purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Oberlin Community Services Council for the provision to the residents of the Oberlin area of emergency assistance to low income persons and a general information and referral program for the 1993 calendar year, said contract to include the following terms and be in the total amount of \$4,000.00:


- 1.) The City will provide \$4,000.00 to the Oberlin Community Services Council to assist them in operating an emergency assistance program for Oberlin area residents. The program will also include a general information and referral program.
- 2.) Upon request, the Oberlin Community Services Council will provide the City with periodic reports and will allow the City to review its financial records, in order to assure the City that the services contemplated are, in fact, being satisfactorily and efficiently provided.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance, were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

A G R E E M E N T

This Agreement made and concluded at Oberlin, Ohio, this

City of Oberlin, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to  
as CITY), and the Oberlin Community Services Council (hereinafter  
referred to as OCSC),

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the OCSC is a non-profit organization which provides  
emergency assistance to low-income persons and a general information  
and referral program which benefits numerous Oberlin residents;  
and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the CITY has by Ordinance No.  
93-24 AC CMS, effective \_\_\_\_\_ April 20, 1993 \_\_\_\_\_, 1993, deemed  
it necessary to authorize the City Manager to enter into an  
agreement with OCSC whereby said OCSC will provide such services to  
the CITY; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY in return for the services to be rendered by  
said OCSC will provide financial and support assistance to the  
OCSC.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other  
valuable consideration, it is agreed by and between the parties  
hereto as follows:

SECTION 1. That for the year 1993, the OCSC will operate an emergency assistance, general information and referral program in the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and provide those services to the citizens of the CITY.

SECTION 2. The CITY will provide the OCSC with the sum of \$4,000.00 towards the cost of operating said program within the City.

SECTION 3. Upon request, the OCSC will provide the CITY with periodic reports and will allow the CITY to review its financial records, in order to assure the CITY that the services contemplated are, in fact, being satisfactorily and efficiently provided.

SECTION 4. The OCSC shall carry public liability insurance in amount and form as approved by the CITY, and agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the CITY from any and all losses, claims, damages, and judgements arising out of or resulting from the operation of said services.
