

ORDINANCE NO. 93-29 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1718 AC CMS
THE "OBERLIN CABLE COMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY ORDINANCE",
AS AMENDED, TO DELETE REFERENCE TO A
CABLE TELEVISION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That all references to a "Cable Television Advisory Committee", and its duties and functions, that are set forth in Ordinance No. 1718 AC CMS, as amended, including, but not limited to the following, are hereby deleted:

SECTION 2. That in all other respects, Ordinance 1718 AC CMS is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
